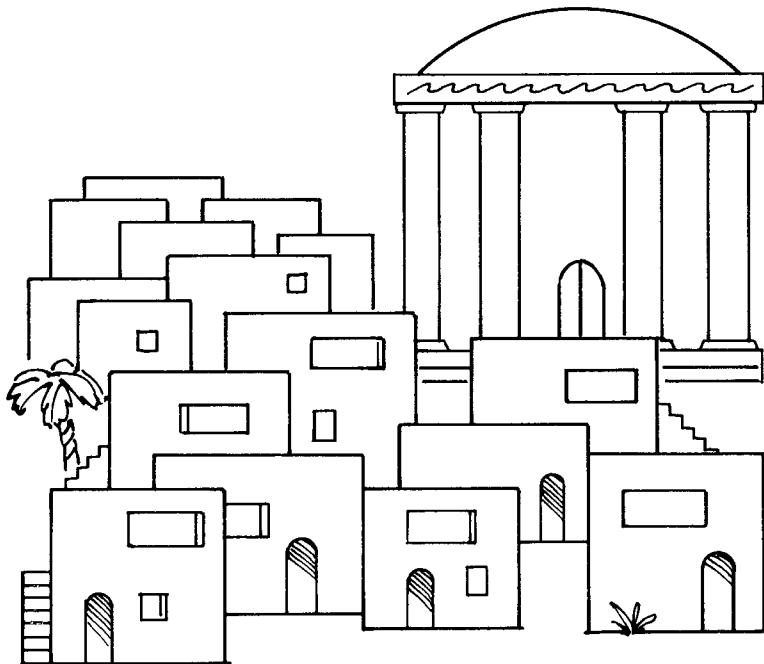




Sometimes it is difficult to gain respect from those who are most familiar with you. Read what Jesus had to say about this situation.

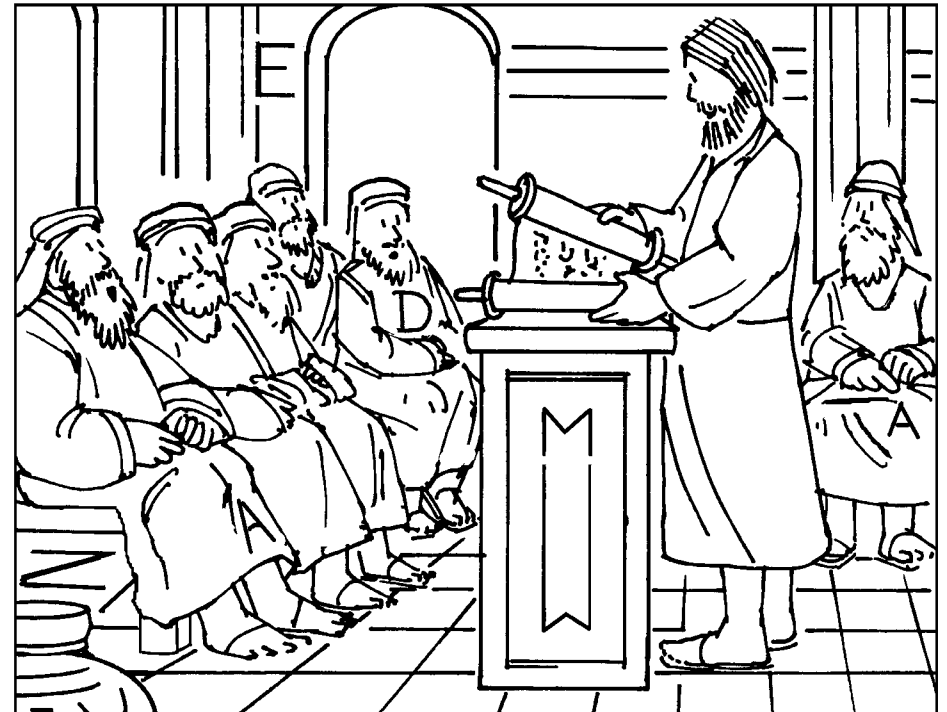

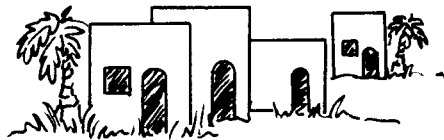
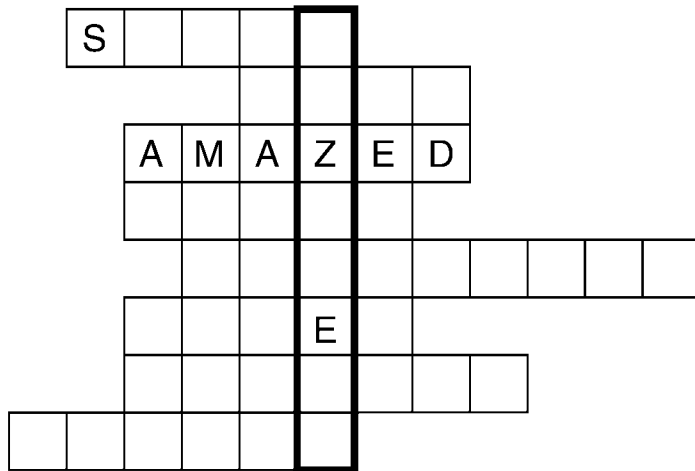
