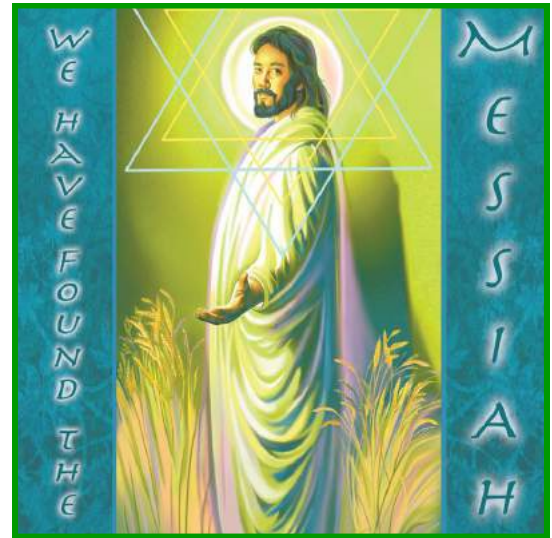

Willow Rising assures that victims have everything they need to create a safe and strong life for themselves and their families. The service areas include Hall, Hamilton, Howard and Merrick counties in Nebraska.

Safety services include

- 24/7 hotline
- Provide counseling and legal aid referrals
- Support and assist in completing the protection and harassment orders
- Maintains 1 safe shelter in GI and utilizes hotels/motels as needed

Self-Sufficiency Services include

- Budgeting, career services, and on going support
- Providing adult and children support groups to help cope with trauma, and set goals for the future

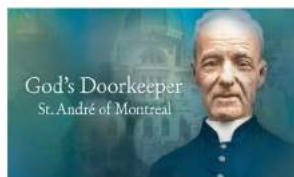
