### **Deacon Bill Buchta**

In 2019, Ph.D. student Steve Jacobs wrote an article called, "I Asked Thousands of Biologists When Life Begins. The Answer Wasn't Popular."

He relates, "as the usual responses began to come in, I found that 5,337 biologists, or 96 percent of the survey, affirmed that a human's life begins at fertilization." This was the case even though 85 percent of the respondents identified as "pro-choice."

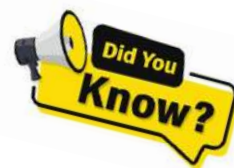

## Human Trafficking Awareness Month

### Do you know the warning signs?

- ◆ Increasingly isolated from friends and family
- ◆ They have an unhealthy relationship with someone in a perceived position of power
- ◆ Their communications or movements are being controlled.

### Some situations that might raise concerns:

- ◆ An employer refuses to give workers a signed contract or asks them to sign a contract in a language they can't read.
- ◆ An employer collects fees from a potential worker for the "opportunity" to work in a particular job.
- ◆ A person is newly showered with gifts or money or otherwise becomes involved in an overwhelming, fast-moving, and asymmetric (large difference in age or financial status) romantic relationship.
- ◆ A person is a frequent runaway and may be staying with someone who is not their parent or guardian.
- ◆ A person is developing a relationship that seems too close with someone they know solely on social media.
- ◆ A person lives with a parent or guardian and shows signs of abuse.
