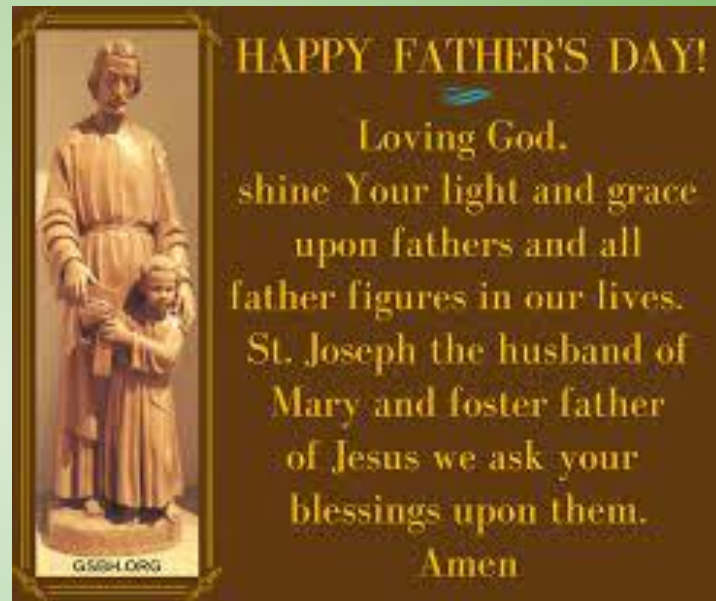

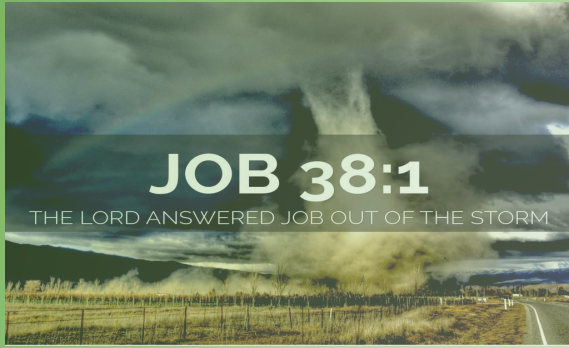

The Lord addressed Job out of the storm and said:

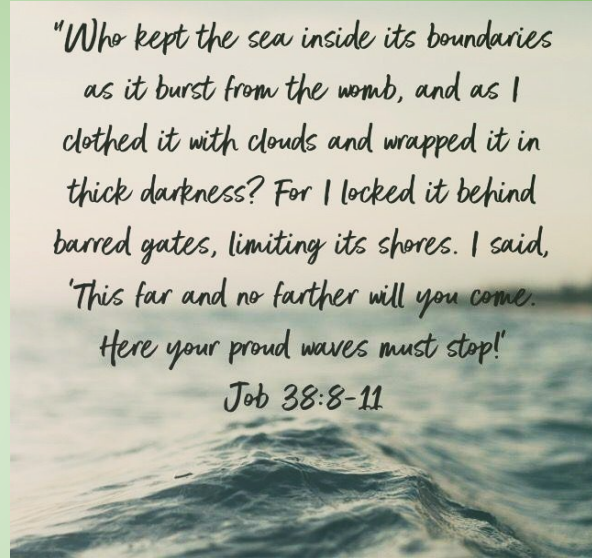

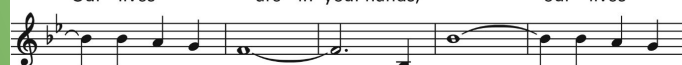

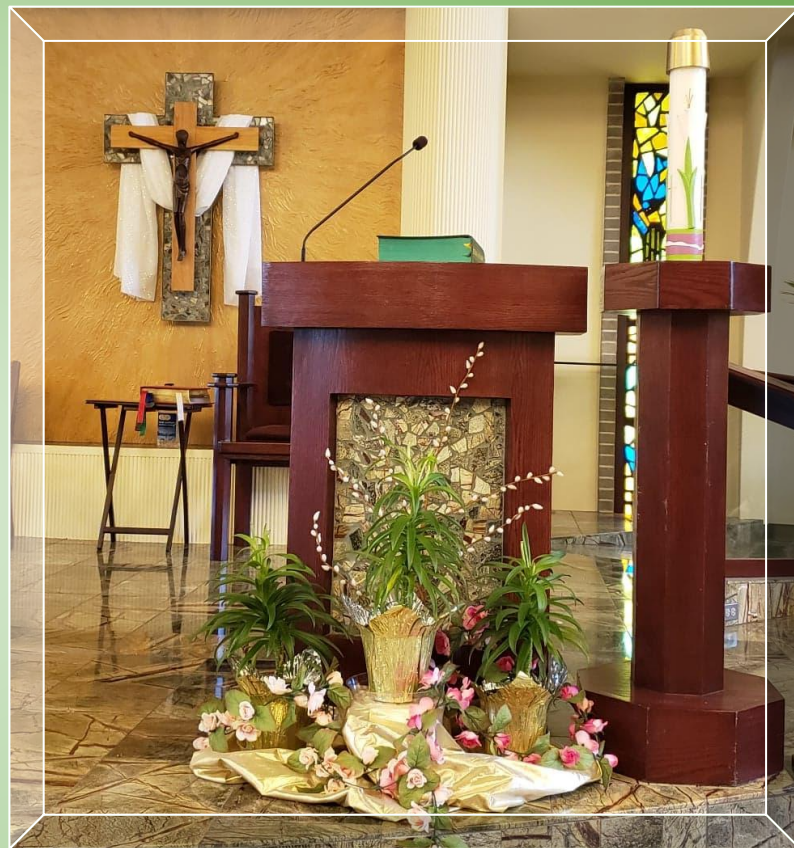
