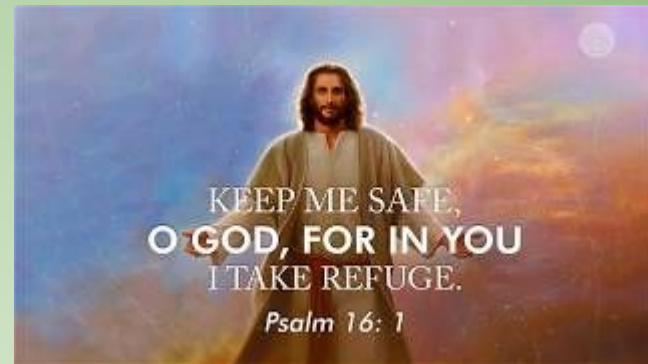

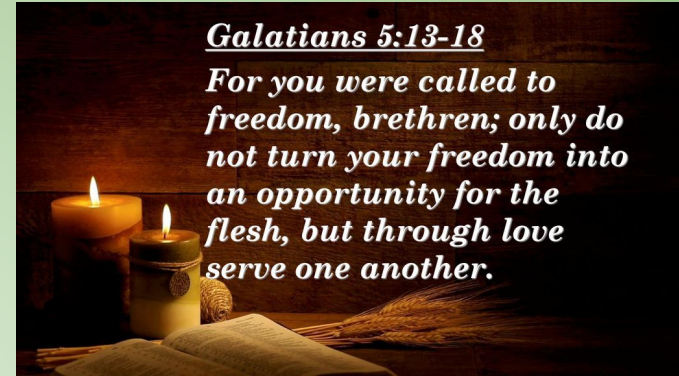


## 2nd Reading Gal 5:1, 13-18

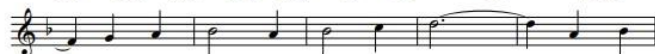



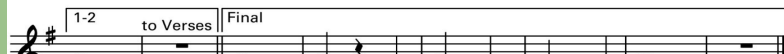
