## 2nd Reading Eph 2:13-18

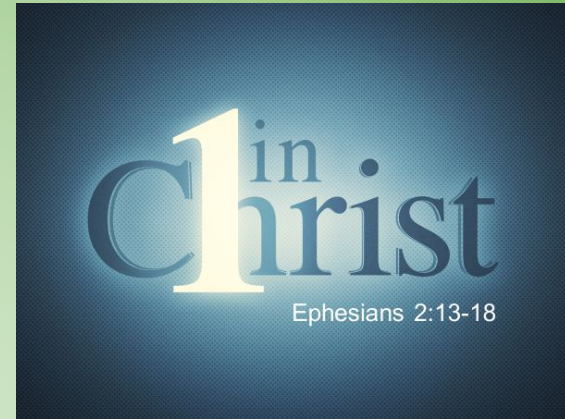
Brothers and sisters:

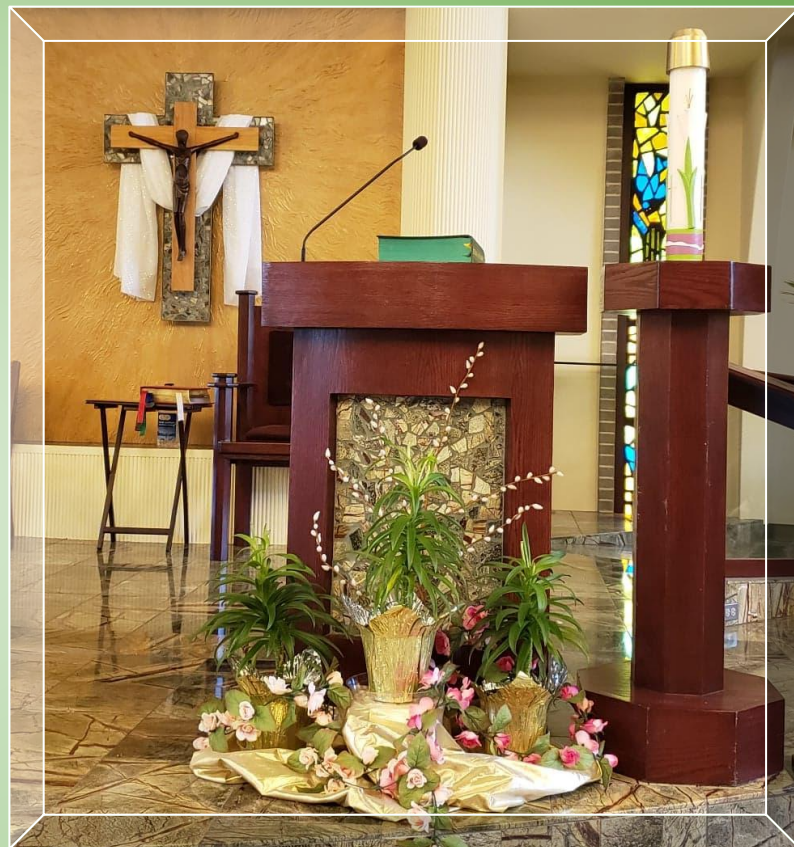
## **Vocations Prayer**
