when he hands over

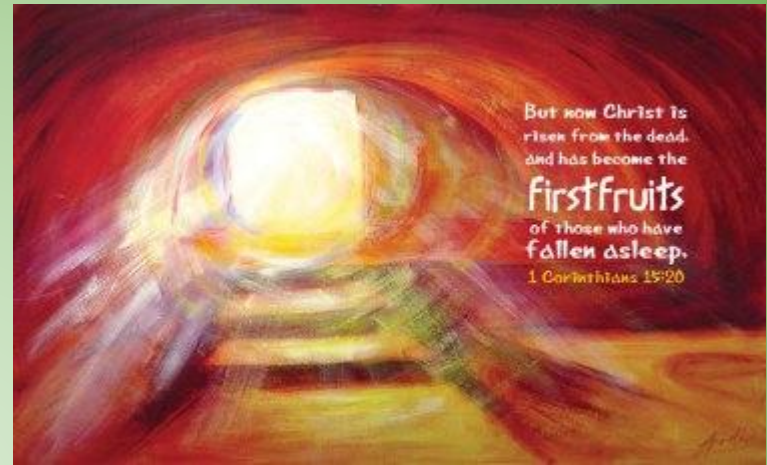
the Kingdom to his God and Father,

## Gospel Jn 6:41-51

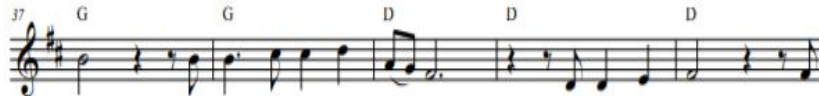
