

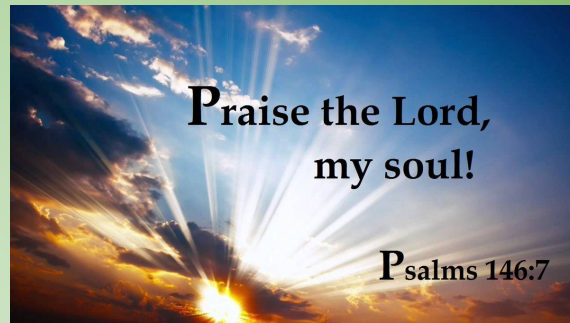




2nd Reading Jas 2:1-5

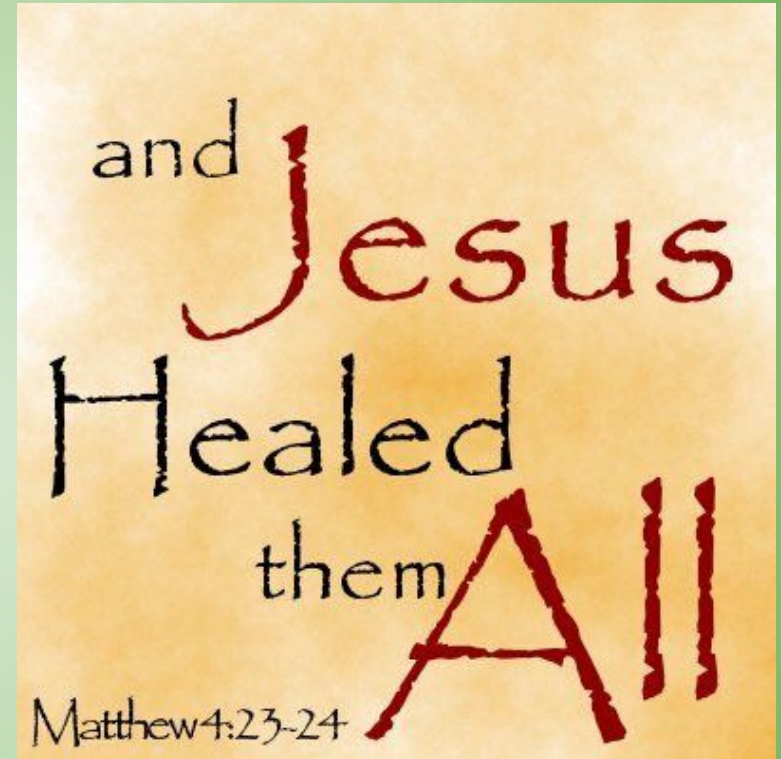




