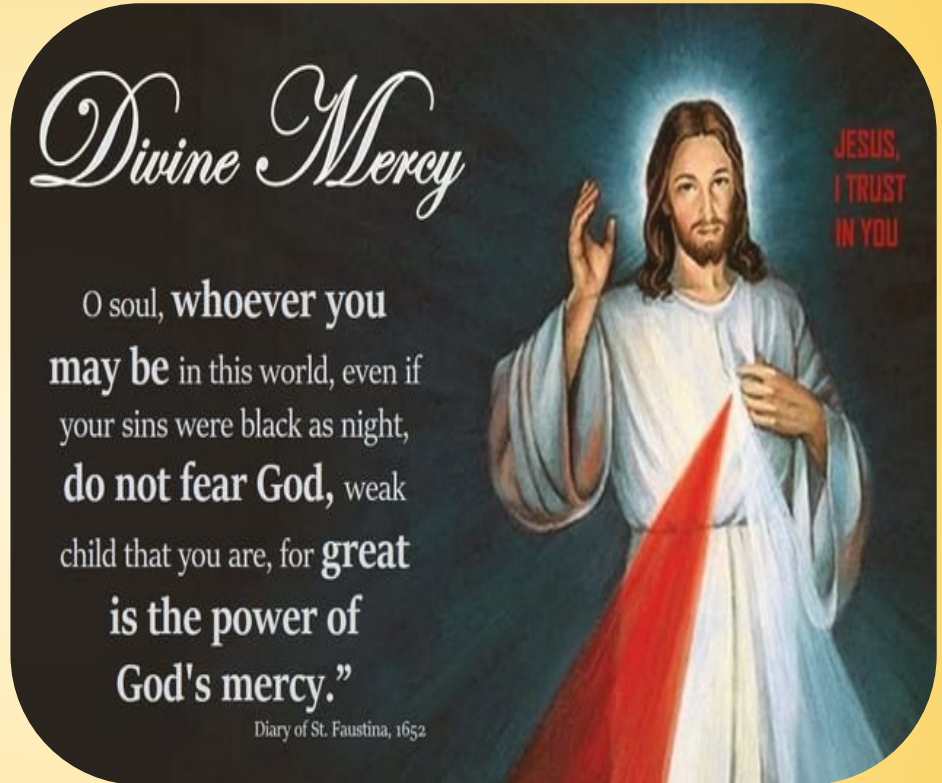

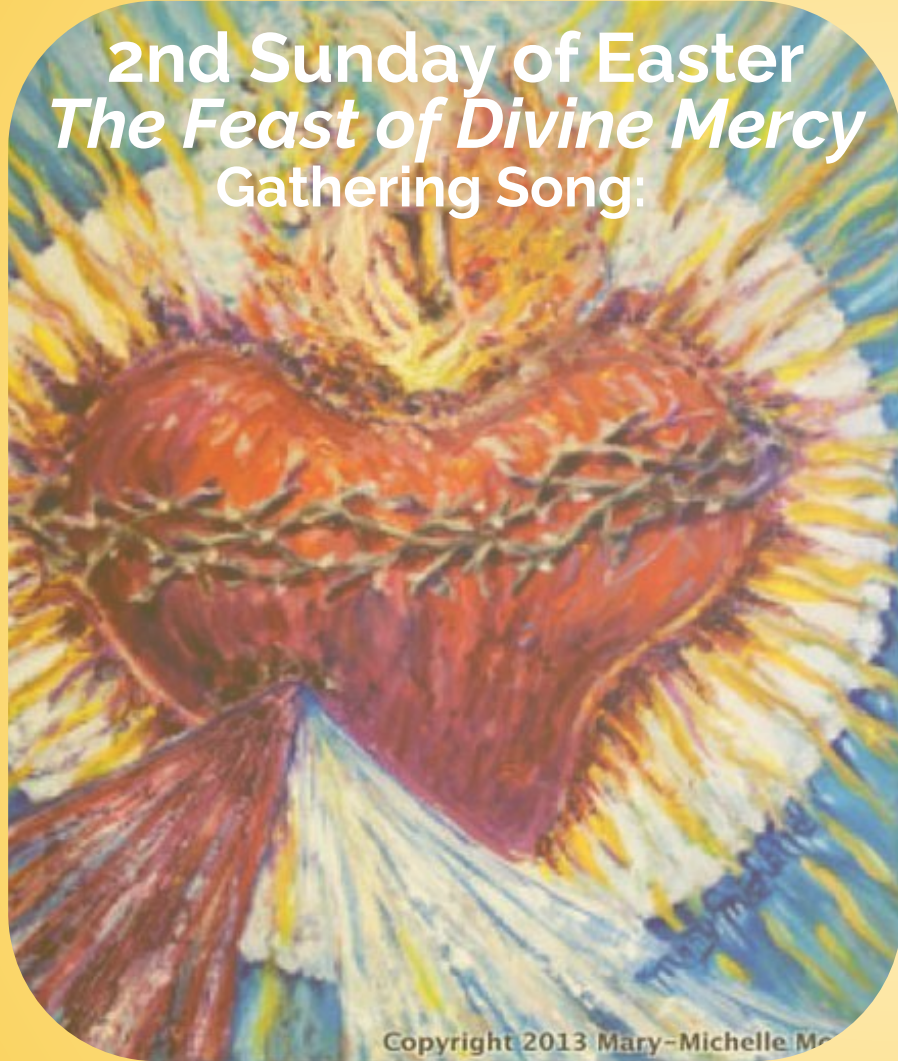

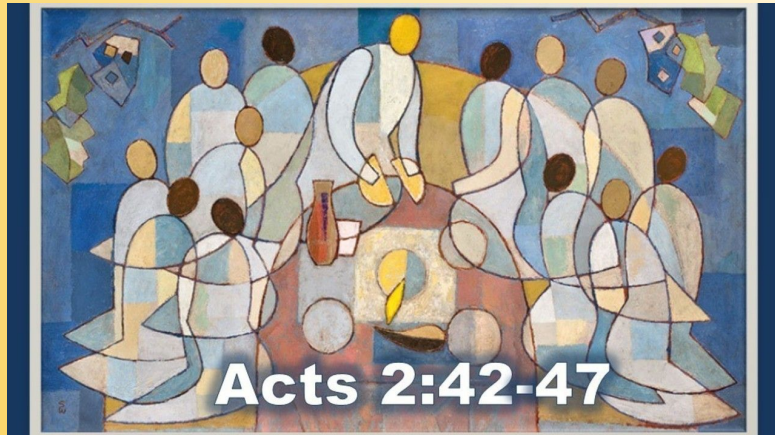


Liturgy of the Word

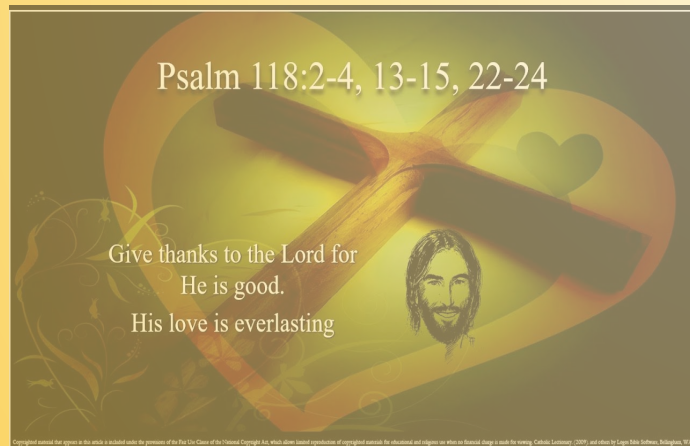

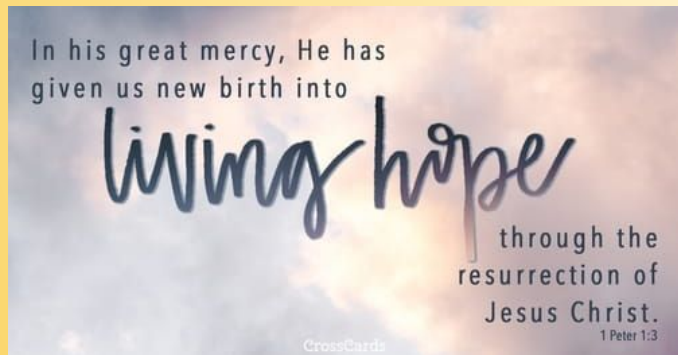




2nd Reading 1 Pt 1:3-9

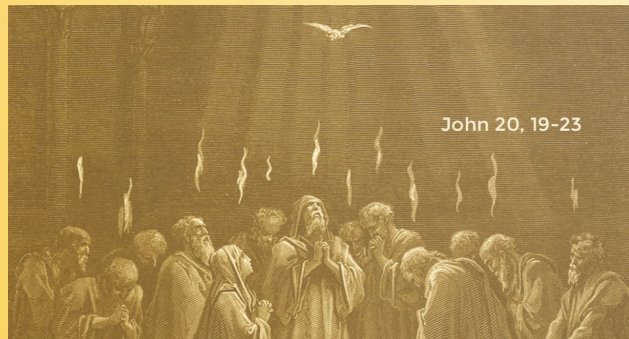

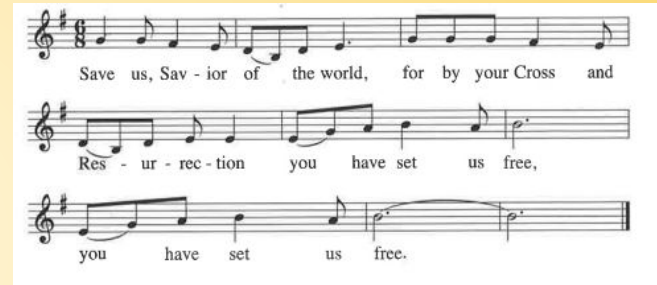

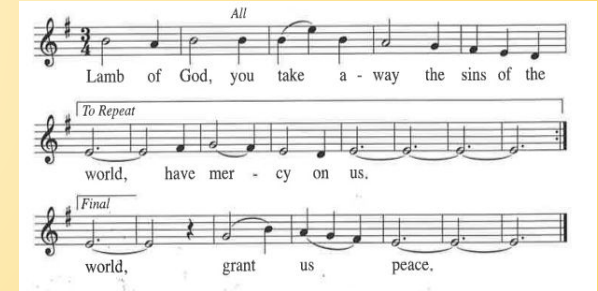
