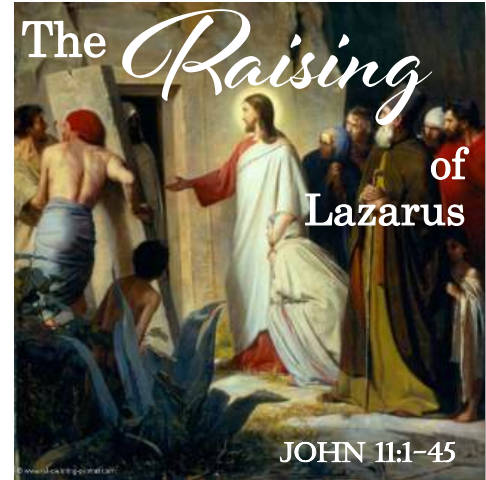

"**Be ready ... so you don't have to get ready**" with Jill Foltz and "**Healing the Heart**" with Jonathan Doll.

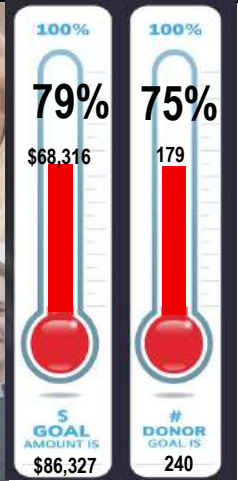

A few months ago, **Mark** loaned his car to a friend who totaled the car. Mark lives in Wood River and works in Grand Island. He needed to find a car in order to keep his job. Mark tried to get a loan for a decent priced car but the bank would only loan him a certain amount of money and he didn't want to be in debt for that long. Mark had a savings account and ended up using all of his savings plus had to use money from his monthly paychecks to pay for the tags and registration. Since then, he has been playing catch up on his bills. He was in need of a partial payment of his rent. After completing his budget, he will be able to support himself in the future and start saving again. St. Leo's helped him with a portion of his rent.

Amy and Trevor's utilities were shut off. They both lost their jobs about 2 months ago. Amy has since been working a job for the last 2 months but her hours decreased in the last week. Trevor found a job and starts on Saturday. We completed their budget and eventually they will be ok; however waiting for those first checks will make it difficult. The awesome thing that they did when they received their tax return was that they paid future rent for 3 months ahead. This has helped them tremendously. This will help them until they figure out their budget and once their income is steady, they will be able to pay all of their bills in the future. I verified this information with their landlord. St. Leo's paid their bill to turn their lights back on.

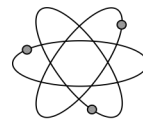

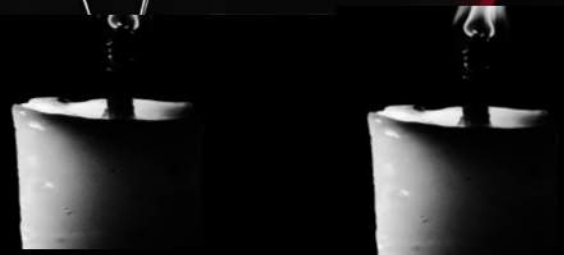
