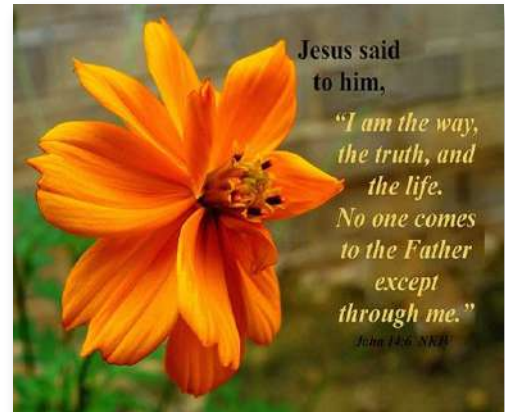

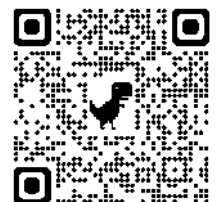

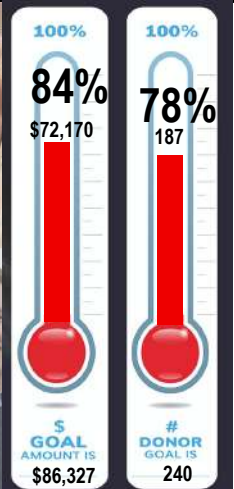

Items can be put in the suitcases in the gathering area on May 2-3. We will also collect small suitcases and duffle bags. — *Thank you!*



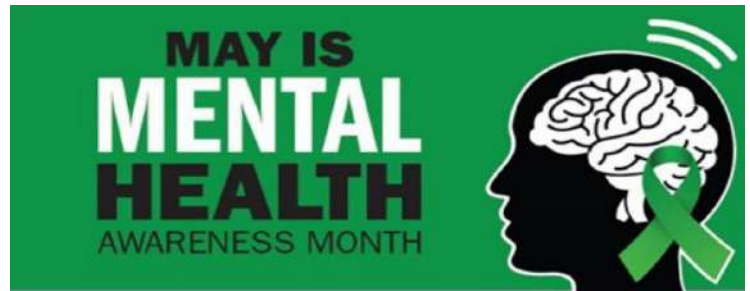
