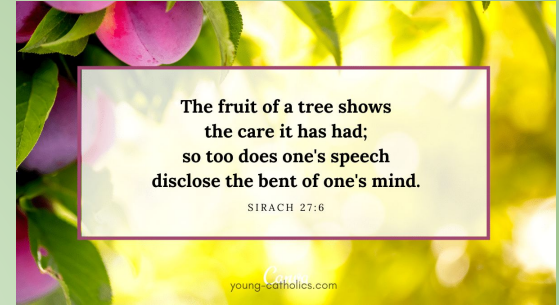

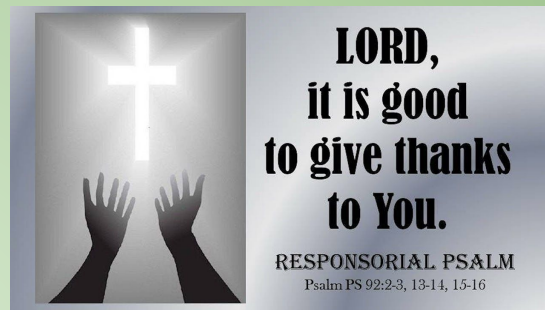

Where, O death, is your victory?

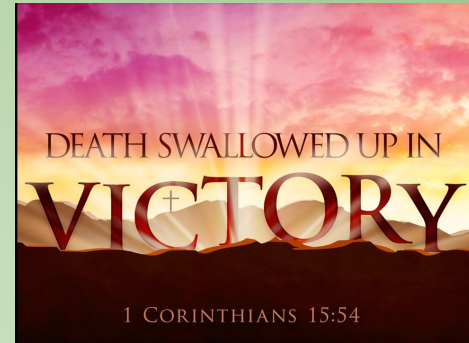

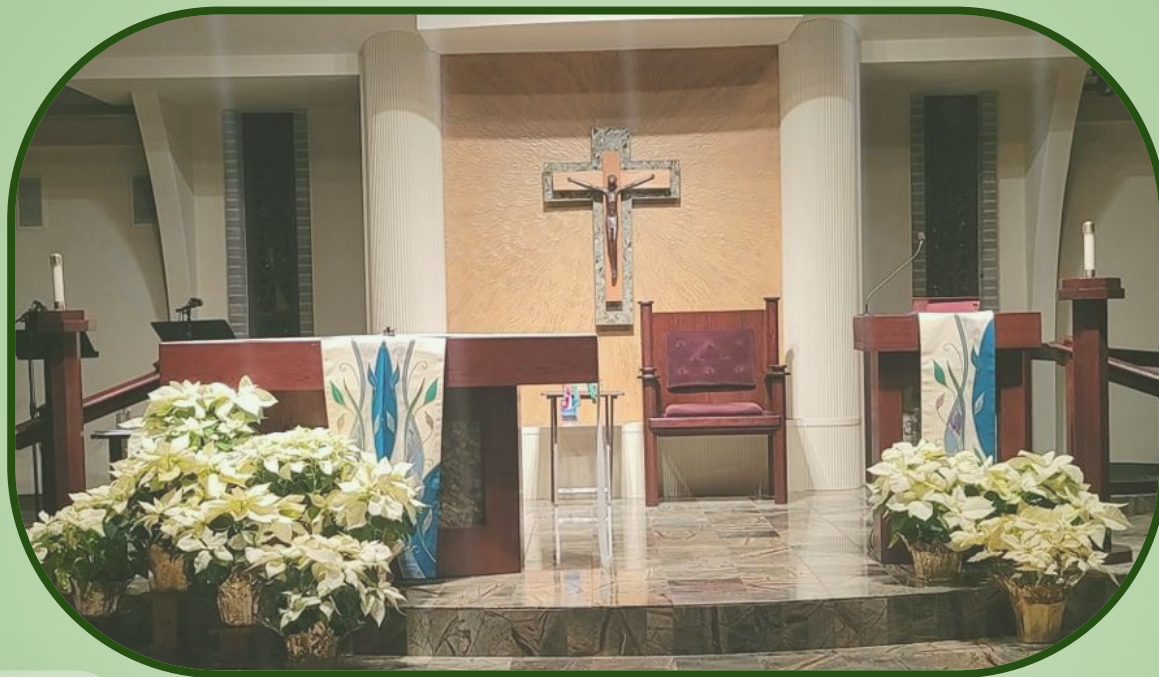
