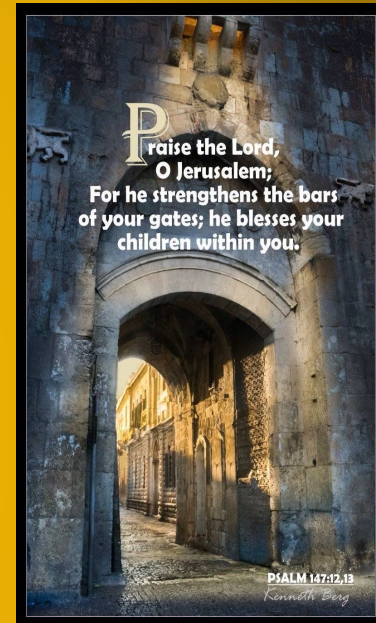

PSALM 147: THE MOST HOLY BODY AND BLOOD OF CHRIST (CORPUS CHRISTI), YEAR A



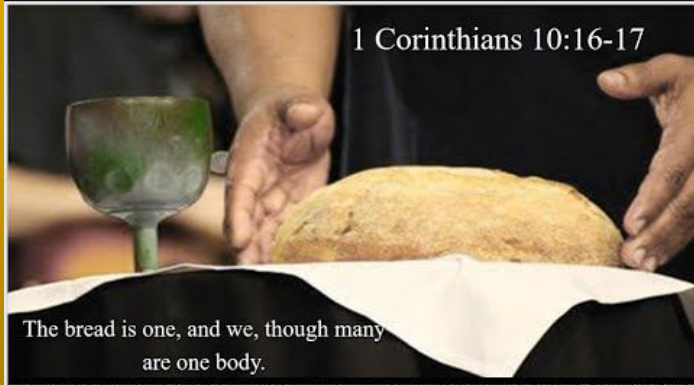

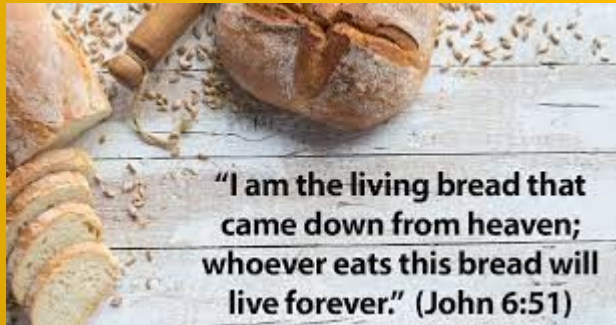

or the consecrated religious life.

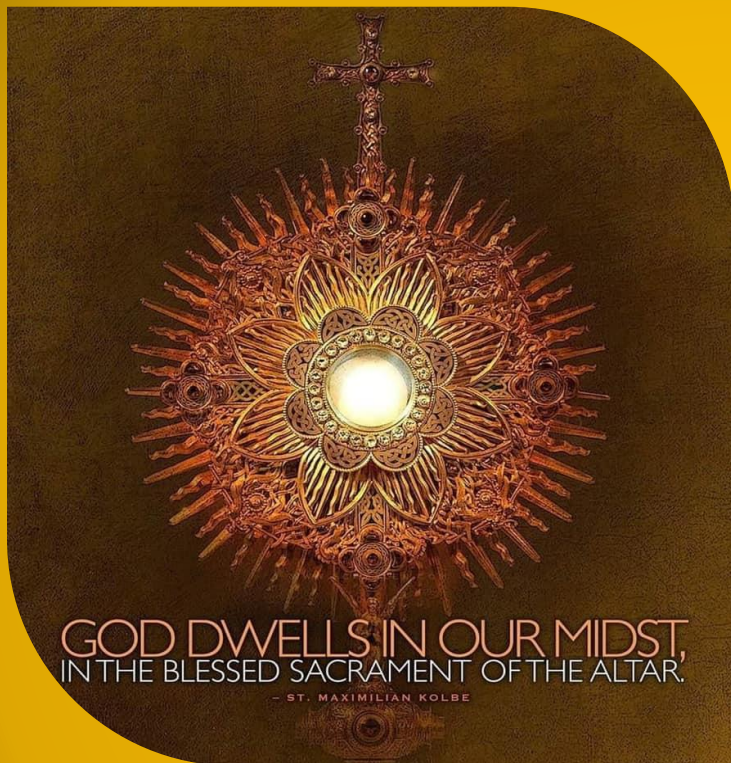
Send your Holy Spirit to inspire them.
