




EPIPHANY HOUSE BLESSING

It has been a tradition in the Catholic Church to use the blessed chalk as part of blessing one's home in the New Year.

The home blessing can be done as follows:
Using the blessed chalk, mark the current year & the initials of the Maji above the outside doorways of your home.

Place a cross between each of the letters.

The prayer to pray after marking your doorframe:

May all who come to our home this year rejoice to find Christ living among us; and may we seek and serve, in everyone we meet, that same Jesus who is Lord of all people, forever and ever. Amen.

The markings over the doors should be left all year round as a sign that yours is a Christian home.

2nd Reading Eph 3:2-3a, 5-6


Brothers and sisters:



Gospel Mt 2:1-12

When Jesus was born in Bethlehem of Judea, in the days of King Herod, behold, magi from the east arrived in Jerusalem, saying,

"Where is the newborn king of the Jews?
We saw his star at its rising
and have come to do him homage."
When King Herod heard this,
he was greatly troubled,
and all Jerusalem with him.

Assembling all the chief priests and the scribes of the people,

He inquired of them where the Christ was to be born. They said to him, "In Bethlehem of Judea,

for thus it has been written through the prophet:

And you, Bethlehem, land of Judah,

are by no means least among the rulers of Judah;




